

RANSOM OF RED CHIEF MOVIE POSTER

Imagine The Ransom of Red Chief is being made into a major motion picture. Design a movie poster for the story. Remember that a poster is designed to get people interested in seeing the movie and, in this case, reading the story that the movie poster is based on.

If you chose to, you can change the time period and setting of the story; however, make sure the changes do not largely impact the plot.

Requirements:

- ____ • Your finished poster must be on a piece of poster board, completed neatly, and with color.
- ____ • Your poster may be only 1/4 computer printed images.
- ____ • An enticing quote from the story must be included on your poster.
- ____ • Include the name of the story (*movie title*) and the author (*director*).
- ____ • Your poster must include a critic's recommendation of the story (movie) and rating. For this part, you must pretend to be a critic and provide a catchy one or two-line statement promoting the story (movie). Then rate it by giving the story (movie) from one to four stars.
- ____ • Real actors should represent **all** the main characters (Sam, Bill, Johnny, and Mr. Dorset). Pick actors to play the characters.
- ____ • On the back of the poster justify your casting choices: write two sentences explaining why you chose the actor to play a certain character (physical and personality).
